





 - Not Reliably Transferable










Margins of Safety

- Instructor Margins
 - Skill & Experience MUST
 Exceed the Curriculum
 Significantly
 - Currency & Fitness
- Airplane Margins
 - Must Exceed the Curriculum Significantly
 - Flight Test Limitations
 - Certification Limitations
