- Must be a current or recently graduated (six months or less) college or university student who is working towards or has earned, a degree in Aviation (Aviation Operations, Aviation Management, Aviation Safety, etc.)
- Must be a student in good standing or recently graduated (less than six months) from an accredited college/university in the United States that is a member of the University Aviation Association
- Must have a minimum of a Private Pilot Airplane and Instrument Certificate
- Must have a current Class III or better Medical Certificate at the time of training
- Must be pilot current at time of training
 - IFR or Landing currency is not required
- Must be a US Citizen or meet current TSA aviation training requirements
- Must complete and submit the attached application supporting documents by the cutoff date of April 1, 2024
- Must have the financial ability to pay for transportation, lodging, meals during the training period
 - o Scholarship only covers the cost of the training program
- Must complete training by December 31, 2024

Application Instructions

- 1. Application must be submitted on 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 inch paper, be neat, legible and in English. It may be completed by computer, typewriter, or by hand, but all signatures must be original and in ink pen electronic or typed signatures are not allowed.
- 2. All blocks must be completed. Indicate "N/A" for "not applicable" where necessary. Use more space or attach an extra page if needed.
- 3. All applicants are responsible for submitting their packets. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that application package is complete in every respect.
- 4. Make a copy of your complete application and retain for your records.


